ENTRY CONDITIONS:

- Students must be sponsored by their national electricity association for the accommodation and travel costs. EURELECTRIC offers free registration to the Vilnius event which includes participation in the two-day event and social side activities (welcome cocktail and gala dinner).
- Students must be in possession of a student card and must not be over 27 years of age.

VIDEO / INFOGRAPHICS / ANIMATION - TOPIC AND TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

- In line with the conference theme, students must submit a video / infographics or animated project on any topic related to the digitisation of the power industry. Please note that the EURELECTRIC conference is NOT a technical event and that issues covered deal primarily with European and international policy impacting on the energy / electricity sector. Projects submitted must therefore not be of a technical nature.
- The video / animation must be in HD format from the video mode 720 (1280×720) min to 1440 (2560x1440) max, with any container and / or codec.
- The video / animation must be sent through www.wetransfer.com
- The infographic should not exceed one A4 page. Picture resolution in 300 DPI, no compression, but original format PSD, AI

DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION: 31 MARCH 2016

Students should contact their national association to discuss their eligibility and participation at the convention. Video / animation / infographics will only be accepted by EURELECTRIC via the national association.

NB: The winner of the Student Award will be selected by participants at the event via live, electronic voting during the conference. Following the handover of the prize, the winner will be expected to briefly present the main ideas of his / her project to an audience of approx. 400 delegates.
