USEFUL INFORMATION



Language

The language of instruction at the University of Ljubljana is predominantly Slovene. The Faculty of Law also offers courses for exchange students in English.

Exchange students are offered a Slovene language course before the start of winter and summer semester.

Accommodation

The University of Ljubljana's International Office will help you find suitable accommodation for the period of your stay in Ljubljana. There are two possibilities: private accommodation and student dormitories.

All rooms in student dormitories are double rooms. Rooms are given to students on a "first come first serve" basis. Internet access is available.

Cost of Living

You will need approximately 550 EUR a month to cover all your basic living costs. Exactly how much you spend will depend on your lifestyle, but this figure takes into account all costs including accommodation, food, public transport and books.

Currency

The official currency in Slovenia is the Euro.

UNIVERSITY OF LJUBLJANA

The University of Ljubljana is an institution with a rich tradition. With its nearly 40,000 undergraduate and graduate students participating in over 300 undergraduate and graduate programs, it ranks among the largest universities in Europe. A total of 23 faculties and 3 art academies employ approximately 6,600 fulltime university teachers, researchers and administrative staff.

The University of Ljubljana was established in 1919 and has its seat in the capital of Slovenia. Students account for almost 20% of the population of Ljubljana, giving the city a youthful and lively character.

The University is located in the centre of Ljubljana, where the central university building and the majority of its departments are located.

FACULTY OF LAW IN BRIEF

The Faculty of Law in Ljubljana is the oldest and the largest law faculty in Slovenia. It offers its students an intellectually exciting learning environment with high academic standards. The faculty promotes both legal knowledge and critical thought.

The Faculty of Law is housed in a renovated facility and provides a distinguished and creative academic setting. The study is organized in line with the principles of the Bologna reform. Consequently, we provide Bologna type study programmes (5 year Single Cycle Master program and 4 year PhD program).



Library

The Faculty of Law library dates back to 1920. Today, it is a modern university library open to the public. The entire library collection encompasses more than 140,000 items. The library is subscribed to more than 300 international and Slovene periodicals and provides access to a variety of electronic databases.



The large and well-lit reading area, where also various lectures and workshops in the fields of legal research and writing are organized, provides the necessary space for approximately 200 students. Due to its extensive collection of books, journals, online information sources and activities, the library is able to carry out its mission of being a house of learning.



COURSES FOR EXCHANGE STUDENTS

Altogether there are about 1,350 students at the Faculty of Law. Every year more than 200 new students begin their law studies at the Faculty. Annually the Faculty receives about 100 exchange students, who spend one or two semesters in Ljubljana, through the Erasmus+ program, CEEPUS program and bilateral exchange agreements.

In order to attract a high number of foreign students and further strengthen its international ties, the Faculty of Law in Ljubljana has introduced courses held in English especially designed for exchange students. The faculty offers 28 such courses that are given either in the winter or summer semester.
