Cilji in kompetence:

Objectives and competences:

The aim of the course is to provide students with a thorough knowledge of alternative dispute resolution (ADR), which is of immense importance as a cheaper and faster way to resolve disputes and as an alternative to court proceedings. The aim of the course is to promote knowledge and understanding of the nature and structure of different forms of alternative dispute resolution, with a particular focus on mediation. One of the main objectives of the course is to introduce students to the different mediation techniques and to master them through practicing them in workshops where students will try out their roles as mediators, parties and lawyers.

Predvideni študijski rezultati:

Intended learning outcomes:

After successfully concluding the course, students will have a good understanding of different forms of alternative dispute resolution and its' core principles. They will understand overall framework of mediation, its' advantages and disadvantages, the mediation procedure, its' structure and the role of all of its participants. They will be aware of the importance of communication skills and use of appropriate language in ADR and will know how to apply several mediation

	techniques. They will possess experiences with preparing for and conducting mediation and participating in the roles of mediator, lawyer and client.
