



EVS for sustainable lifestyles and youth participation in the Alps **CIPRA International is looking for a volunteer!**

Are you between 17 and 30 years old and come from Slovenia? Are you interested in learning how an international environmental NGO works? Would you like to live in Liechtenstein for 12 months? Would you like to get involved in social innovation and youth-project-work? Do you think the Alps are important? Then the European Voluntary Service (EVS) is the right thing for you – and you are right for us!

How does it work?

An EVS project funded by Erasmus+ and it is a partnership between two promoting organisations. These organisations are responsible for recruiting volunteers for their project.

Volunteers participate in EVS through a “Sending Organisation” in the country where they live and a “Receiving Organisation” that receives and hosts them during their time of service.

Project last 12 months, from March 2019 and as a volunteer you can work in a field of environment and international cooperation, with special focus on social innovation and youth projects in alpine countries. At the end of your EVS period, you will receive a certificate confirming your participation and describing your project – the “**Youthpass**”.

You will receive free accommodation, food, insurance, pocket money and up to 180 euros for the travel costs to and from Liechtenstein.
