

## LJUBLJANA – AUGSBURG CONFERENCES ON CONTEMPORARY ISSUES OF INTERNATIONAL LAW

Faculty of Law, University of Ljubljana organized on July 3, 2015 the third conference in the series of international conferences **Ljubljana – Augsburg Conferences on Contemporary Issues of International Law**. The conferences are organized in cooperation with the Faculty of Law, University of Augsburg and under the chairmanship of dr. Vasilka Sancin from the Faculty of Law, University of Ljubljana and Dr. Stefan Lorenzmeier from the Faculty of Law, University of Augsburg. The intention of the conferences is to strengthen the cooperation between the two law faculties and common scientific research work while discussing contemporary challenges of international law. The main topic of the two conferences organised in 2015 is **Contemporary Challenges of International Trade and Investment Law**. The next conference will take place on December 10, 2015 at the Faculty of Law, University of Augsburg.

The conference panellist presented various issues of international trade and investment law in the three panels: **Macro and Micro Aspects of the World Trade Organization, Transatlantic Trade and Investment Partnership (TTIP) from the International Legal Perspective** and **Trade and Investment in a Wider International Legal Context**. The conference participants, which included government officials, lawyers, journalists, foreign and domestic professors and researchers and students from both faculties, joined the panellists in a lively discussion that followed each panel. We are honoured that the conference was attended also by the Ambassador of the Republic of Germany dr. Anna Elisabeth Prinz, who greeted the participants, expressed support for scientific cooperation between the two faculties and also joined in the discussion on the TTIP.
